This communication is a follow-up to my letter of March 19, 2002, and in response to American Airlines' request for additional flight slots at the Long Beach Airport (LGB).

All airlines with LGB flight slots were asked if they were willing to relinquish any of their slots. All slot holders have responded that they do not desire to relinquish slots. As such, your request for four additional final airline flight slots cannot be granted at this time.

As mentioned in my March 19th letter, temporary use slots are available at this time, and may be requested by American Airlines pursuant to Section 9 of Flight Allocation Resolution C-27843 (you have a copy).

Should you wish to appeal this finding, administrative remedies are available pursuant to Chapter 16.43 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, the applicable portion of which is attached for your information.
