Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 5.61 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, and upon written application on file in the office of the City Manager, which application by this reference is made a part hereof, permission is hereby granted to:

to enter upon and use the "location(s)" described below for the purpose of photographing or filming the following:

MTV's Summer on the Run

The period, times and location(s) covered by this permit are:

LOCATIONS & ACTIVITIES: Filming will take place on the beach between 55th and Balboa. Film Company will build a stage and compound on beach area. Stage will be placed as to leave 50ft buffer between the seawall and the start of the compound. Film Company may not interfere with bike path or normal activity on beach. Film Company will have two video feed trucks parked on S/S of Ocean Ave. west of 55th place in parking lane in front of wall. Film Company will have one portable restroom parked on the west side of 55th place next to trucks. Portable restroom is for crew only. All extras must use restroom facilities at MTV compound at 54th place lot. Stage and compound will be constructed within a 100 ft. fenced area on the beach. MTV will provide 24-hour security. Security numbers must be based on crowd as well as construction needs.

During the week of 5/24/04 through 5/28/04 and the week of 5/7/04-5/11/04 film company will have a total of 100 people on the beach with RV. There will be no live performances and/or amplified sound. Extras will be escorted from Granada lot to beach compound via small groups by MTV. **UPON COMPLETION OF EACH TAPING EXTRAS TO BE ESCORTED BACK TO BUS PICK UP AREA. BUS PICK UP AND DROP OFF WILL BE AT THE GRANADA PARKING LOT.** MTV will actual begin constructing stage and lighting on Thursday 5/27/04 with set and compound being disassembled by Friday 5/11/04. Beach compound and MTV compound set up and strike may not begin prior to 8am each day and must be completed by 6pm each day. Compound will consist of RV, Hot Tub Jumbotron, Scissor lifts, condors, camera platforms, 28 by 24 stage with 2 8ft round pods, 5 Honda Civics and 5 cameras (4 handheld with 1 24ft jib) Construction and rehearsal continuing until 5/30/04. All rehearsals and sound checks on 5/29/04 and 5/30/04 must be done between the hours of 10am and 5pm. There will be no actual filming, cast members or extras during this time however there will be minimal amplified sound for equipment testing.

The week of 5/31/04-6/4/04 Film Company will start sound tests at approximately 9am and will have 1st rehearsal at 11am with extras arriving via bus to Granada lot at 12:30pm. Extras will be escorted from Granada lot to beach compound via small groups by MTV. Live taping will begin at 2pm and end at 3pm with additional taping beginning between 4:30pm and 5:30pm with activity completely ended by 6:00pm. Film Company will have additional rehearsal between 3pm and 4:30pm. During taping hours film company will have live performances. **UPON COMPLETION OF EACH TAPING EXTRAS TO BE ESCORTED BACK TO BUS PICK UP AREA AT THE GRANADA PARKING LOT.**

On 5/23/04 Film company will start shooting City footage. This will be no more than 3 people with a hand held camera. MTV shall not impede pedestrian or vehicular traffic at anytime. MTV shall obey all traffic laws while filming.

The List of Performers:

The City stated that the list of performers would dictate the staffing levels of public safety officers by the City. From this point forward, all changes to list of performers provided to the City on 5/18/04 (by this reference this letter is made a part of this permit). must be approved in writing by the City of Long Beach. No filming shall be conducted at any locations other than those site locations listed below unless City written approval is obtained 2 business days prior to the shoot.

Dates Times for each location must be approved by the Filming Office prior to shooting.

Final Site Plan

A final site plan submitted by MTV and approved by the City on 5/18/04 (by this reference this letter is made a part of this permit). shall not be changed or altered without written approval by the City of Long Beach.

Security Plans

A final Security Plan submitted by MTV and approved by the City on 5/18/04 (by this reference this letter is made a part of this permit). shall not be changed or altered without written approval by the City of Long Beach. In addition all uniformed or badged officers of the Long Beach Fire and Police Departments shall be provided full access to the venue upon request. All members of the Office of Special Events and Filming shall be provided full access to all areas and will be provided the appropriate credentials. All private security guards (including talent guards) may not be armed at anytime at filming venues.

Use of the City's Image and locations

The use of the City's images shall be pursuant to the letter provided by MTV on 5/18/04 (by this reference this letter is made a part of this permit). Any changes to the use of the City's image shall require the City's written approval.

Other Requirements:

Profanity will not be acceptable at anytime. MTV must be courteous to residents at all times.

1. Permittee shall pay to the city of Long Beach ("City") the following fee:

Said fees and deposit shall be paid at least three (3) days prior to the commencement of filming activities.

Permittee must provide City of Long Beach with 24 hours notice for changes to dates or times of this permit. Additional charges assessed to Permittee if notice is less than 24 hours.

2. Permittee shall pay to City within ten (10) days after receipt of invoices the actual costs incurred by City departments, which render services or provide equipment materials or supplies for or in connection with filming activities authorized by this Permit. Within thirty (30) days following the conclusion of the filming activity, City shall submit invoices and billing for the actual City departmental service charges. City shall use the deposit to compensate City for the actual City departmental services charges. Permittee shall pay any unpaid balance thereof within ten (10) days after receipt of the City's invoices. City may retain the deposit separately or it may commingle the deposit with City's general and other funds. City shall not be required to pay Permittee interest on the deposit.

3. Permittee acknowledges and agrees that the permission granted herein does not include permission to photograph or otherwise use privately-owned property and that it shall be permittee's obligation to obtain all requisite consents and permits to photograph, film, or otherwise use such privately-owned property.

4. Nothing herein shall obligate Permittee to photograph or film, to use such photographs or films, or to otherwise use said locations. Permittee is granted for all times the irrevocable right to use the photographs and or film taken by it; provided, however, said photographs and or films shall not be used in a manner derogatory to the City of Long Beach.

5. Permittee shall at all times, in its use of the locations and in the conduct of its operations thereon, comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations enacted by federal, state, municipal and or other governmental bodies or departments or offices thereof. If the location(s) described above include public streets and alleys, Permittee's use thereof shall not substantially interfere with the public's right to use said public streets and alleys or the operation of emergency equipment in the location(s). Permittee shall notify the

City's Film coordinator in writing of the date or dates of use of the location(s) at least five (5) days prior thereof and concurrently submit a written traffic control plan for approval by City assuring that the public's use of the streets will not be substantially interfered with. During the use of the location(s), Permittee shall strictly comply with the provision of the approved traffic control plan and shall keep, maintain and return the location(s) in a neat, clean and sanitary condition.

6. Permittee agrees to defend, protect, indemnify, and hold the City of Long Beach, its commissions, boards, officers, employees, and agents free and harmless from and against any and all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, loss, liens, costs, expense and liability, of any kind or nature whatsoever, including attorneys' fees and court costs ("claims"), for an injury to or death of persons or damage to property (including property owned by said City), which may be brought, made, filed against, imposed upon or sustained by said City, its commissions, boards, officers, employees and agents, and which claims may, in whole or in part, arise from or be attributable to or be caused, directly or indirectly, by the use of or operations conducted upon said location(s) authorized to be used herein, whether such use or operations be made or performed by Permittee, its officers, agents, or employees, or by any persons' action with the knowledge and consent, expressed or implied, of permittee, and regardless of whether any act, omission or negligence of the City of Long Beach or their officers or employees contributed. The indemnity provided herein does not require payment as a condition precedent to recovery under the same.

7. As a condition to the effectiveness of this Permit but not in limitation of Permittee's obligations under paragraph 6 above, Permittee shall procure and maintain in full force and effect at all times while the Permit shall be in effect, a policy or policies of comprehensive general liability insurance with coverage at least as broad as Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability Coverage's "occurrence" Form CG0001 and with limits of coverage of not less than \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit. Said insurance shall name the City of Long Beach, its commissions, boards, offices, employees, and agents as additional insured. Permittee shall furnish a certificate evidencing such insurance to the City Manager for approval.

8. Permittee shall reimburse upon demand for the actual replacement or repair cost of any damaged or destroyed City property.

9. City reserves the right to summarily revoke this Permit at any time upon written notice to Permittee from the City Manager for reasons of disaster, emergency, or other change of circumstances which in the sole discretion of the City Manager necessitates a revocation of this Permit.

10. This Permit has been issued under and shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 5.61 of the Long Beach Municipal code.

11. Recognition shall be given the City of Long Beach in the credits, if credits appear.

12. Permittee agrees to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990/ADA and shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Long Beach for any liability arising from failure to comply therewith.

PROMOTIONAL AGREEMENTS: MTV must distribute flyers promoting one business each day to extras on set. The Office of Special Events and Filming will furnish promotional material.

LOCATION OF "NO PARKING SIGNS": No Parking to be posted from 5/24/04 at 8am through 6/11/04 at 6pm on the S/S of Ocean Ave. from 55th Place 100ft west. W/S of 55th Place between Ocean and Beach. This area will be used for beach access. No Equipment or crew parking in this area except for Portable restroom. From 5/29/04-6/11/04 all spaces except for the 9 closest to the Launch Ramp in the Claremont lot and all the spaces in the 54th place lot. All spaces to be closest to the water and posted together as film company will be fencing the compound area. 5/24-6/4/04 from noon to 6pm each day B/S of the 50 spaces in the south portion of the far east end of the Granada lot. (excluding weekend dates of 5/29, 5/30, 6/5, 6/6). This area will be used for extra drop off and pick up. From 5/31/04 through 6/11/04 from 11am to 7pm each day on the W/S of Pine Ave. from Seaside Way south to entrance of Pike.

5/31/04-6/4/04 Extras will park in the Pike parking structure. Arrangements have been made with Sharon Daniels, Janice Shermun and Marc Ruiz.

LOCATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL: A Traffic Management Plan will be developed for emergency access and residential access to peninsula at all times. Plan will be set in place to alleviate gridlock within area. Any and all costs incurred will be at film company's expense.

If any additional city services are called upon based on over crowding film company will be billed for additional staffing.
